

## AGILITY MATCH

We will have an agility match at the WDTC agility building on Sunday, April 15, 2018. The match will be run as much like a trial as possible to help you, and your dog, recreate that experience. Therefore, you will have the same requirements as at a trial, dogs in crates, dogs on lead except when in the ring or using the practice jump, no treats in the ring. We will allow toys, however.

We will measure dogs. If you don't have your permanent height card and want to practice having your dog measured this will be a good opportunity.

The Fun Match will start at 9 a.m. with an Excellent Standard course followed by a Novice standard course. Following standard, we will have an Excellent Jumps with Weaves course followed by a Novice Jumps with Weaves course. Dogs currently participating at the OPEN level are also encouraged to participate in the excellent courses. We will use courses designed by Lavonda Herring (our Judge for the Whitewater trials on April 27-29, 2018).

You may enter as many dogs as you like. You may run the whole courses or work parts of the courses.

Cost: \$5 per dog per course for WDTC members; \$7 for non-members – 2 minutes of course time. Entry limits: 75 runs for the day.

We will use rubberized contacts and electronic timers
